Important Info about the chalet :

1. The chalet is lower than the road, so the water is evacuated with a pump system. For this reason, it's very important to **only throw toilet paper in the WC, nothing else !** Otherwise the pump will block with very nasty consequences. Cost occurred in case of problems will be charged back.
2. There is a manual in the chalet for Hifi, washing, fireplace etc...please read the manual before using any of them. Its not long, but will avoid problems. **Never change any of the cables or settings on the Hifi or video equipment !** Moving will unplug the cables.
3. Wood for the fireplace is not available, so you'll have to buy some in moutiers or on the way up to Les Allues if you like to lit the fireplace. You can also order woods to be delivered on **09 66 44 05 04** (Wood's Stock Steph).
4. We don't allow pets .
5. It's a non smoking chalet .
6. You will need to leave the chalet in a broom clean state by 10:00.
7. The warm water is provided by 2 warm water tanks that have total of 400 liter. This is much over the average consumption, but if it runs out, it means you'll have to wait a day for it to warm again. As the pressure on the water is quite high, do not open the tap completely, as then the water runs out quicker.
8. Wifi is provided and is most of the time working, but as it depends on quite some factors (telecom, provider, ..), I can not guarantee internet to be up all the time.
9. If you rent the 2 chalets, please at the end of your stay, put all objects back to the chalet where they belong.
10. In case you bring your own bed linen. In both chalets there are 3 double beds. In chalet A in the basement there are 3 single beds

(semi-bunk) . In chalet B in the basement there is 1 double and 1 single (semi-bunk) . The Chalets have 3 double duvets and 3 singles.

Garbage :

Glass and packing needs to be sorted out separately. 3 garbage's containers (glass/packaging/rest) are down the road, on the ride hand side approx 250 meters from the chalet.

Sauna :

The sauna is shared between the chalets, so don't leave any belongings in the sauna. It can be used for shower, but shouldn't be used as private bathroom for the rooms in the cellar. The sauna can be used between 12:00 and 23:00.

Parking:

There are 2 parking spaces that can be used. If you have more cars, then please use some of the public parking spaces up the road. Please park the cars close. 5 cars in total should fit on the lot.

Kitchen:

The coffee machine is a fully automated and works on normal coffee beans.

There is a cheese fondue and a gourmet system. They are shared between the chalets, so if you like to organize a fondue or racklett, then ask the neighbors. if its not in your chalet. As the items move around we have no knowledge of where they are 😊

Skiing in the area :

Both the ski-bus and the Gondola to Meribel Chaudanne are for free. Also there is free parking at the gondola. From the chalet to the Gondola is about 980 meter. From the chalet to the bus is about 800 meter.

When there is enough snow, it is possible to ski back to Les Allues. The slope ends at the bus stop. Otherwise you can come back with the gondola (runs till about 1630) or with the bus (runs till about midnight)

There is possibility to rent ski-storage at Meribel Chaudanne.

Myself I always throw the ski's in the car. Park at the gondola and take the gondola to the Chaudanne. I come back on ski's , except when I am doing apres-ski in Meribel. Then I come back with the bus.

Tip from my sis : There is free parking at Meribel Village (start of golf chairlift) and the bar at the end of the slope is also alright, so she drives there in the morning.

The village :

There is a ski-rental shop in the village of Les Allues near the bus station. Also a small shop for bread, grocery etc.. There is a couple of restaurants and bars in the village. For the restaurants its best to make a reservation as they get crowded in the season. The grocery shop is quite limited so best is to do some shopping before driving up to Les Allues. (between Moutiers and Les Allues is a Super U that seems to have excellent Tomme de Savoy)

Ski passes :

Ski passes can be ordered online, so it saves on queuing.

Ski rental :
